English and Hindi Department attended the webinar on "Power of Language" organized by Together for Education.

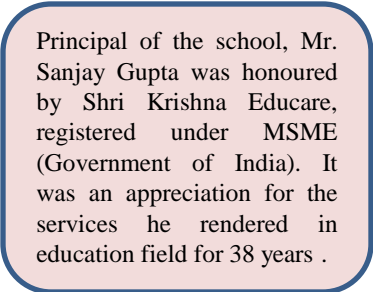
Mathematics Department attended the workshop on "Unfolding Mathematics Teaching" which was conducted by Ratna Sagar, an out agency.
